1. Enrol in your Course

Book your course online or by calling our friendly customer service team and provide a copy of your white card (or soft).

2. Attend 2 Days of Training

You will receive 2 full days of training involving theory & practical plus up to 1/2 a day for assessment.

3. TC Practical Experience

After completing at least 20 hours of free work placement (or through your existing employer) you can be assessed for your VicRoads TC1 Card.

4. Receive your credentials

After attending the course and completing the practical requirements, you will receive a Statement of Attainment for the skill set **RIISS00058** Traffic Controller Skill Set For Urban Streets And Low Volume Rural Roads (**RIICOM201E** Communicate in the Workplace, **RIIWHS205E** Control Traffic with Stop-Slow Bat, **RIIWHS206** Control Traffic with Portable Traffic Control Devices and Temporary Traffic Signs) & a digital VicRoads Card for TC1.
